The main meeting room is a light and roomy space, with seating for 50 people (16 with 2m social distancing). Sized approximately 8m x 8m with easy level access it incorporates a loop hearing system with a large blank wall for projection. On the same level there is a fully accessible toilet, additional toilet and access to the central kitchen. Wifi available.

Wyn's meeting room (upstairs meeting room) is an intimate meeting space, with seating for 30 people (10 with 2m social distancing). Sized approximately 6.8m x 6.5m it is accessed by a shallow stair-way from the ground floor. On the upper floor there is a regular toilet. Downstairs on the ground floor there is a fully accessible toilet, additional toilet and access to the kitchen. Wifi available.

The small meeting room is a light and convenient space, with seating for 10 people (4 with 2m social distancing). Sized approximately 4.6m x 4.2m with easy level access from the main entrance. There is an electric serving hatch to the central kitchen. On the same level there is a fully accessible toilet, additional toilet and access to the central kitchen. Wifi available.

The Meeting House is situated just off the A6 Matlock Street, about 300m south of Bakewell Town Centre, at the end of Chapel Row (marked as Chapel Lane on some maps). The postcode is DE45 1EL. The entrance is a narrow lane located between Bakewell Methodist Church and The Manners Hotel.

As is often the case with central Bakewell buildings parking is restricted. There is parking space for a maximum of 6 cars, restricted for disabled parking or elderly people as well as loading/unloading. Public carparks in the town are within walking distance. There are bike storage facilities.
